Subj: POLICY DECISION MEMORANDUM (PDM) 001-03; INTRODUCTORY
FLIGHT SCREENING (IFS) FOR ALL STUDENT NAVAL PILOTS (SNP)
Ref: (a) CNATRINST 3501.1
(b) Program Authorization (PA) 106

1. Effective immediately, successful completion of the Introductory Flight Screening (IFS) program, delineated in reference (a), by all Student Naval Pilots (SNPs) is a mandatory prerequisite to attending Aviation Preflight Indoctrination (API) at Naval Aviation Schools Command (NASC). IFS completion for Officer Candidate School (OCS) SNPs is governed by references (a) and (b). IFS completion by all other SNPs is governed by this PDM and reference (a).

2. The IFS program screens all SNPs, except those with prior flight time who meet requirements in reference (a) for the skills and attributes required to successfully complete Primary pilot training. Per reference (a), all SNPs will receive 24 (minimum) to 25 hours (maximum funded) of civilian aviation flight training, with associated ground training from a Federal Aviation Regulation (FAR) Part 141 Pilot School, services paid by Chief of Naval Air Training (CNATRA) IFS Program office. Successful completion of IFS is determined solely by CNATRA. Waivers shall be submitted per requirements in reference (a).
